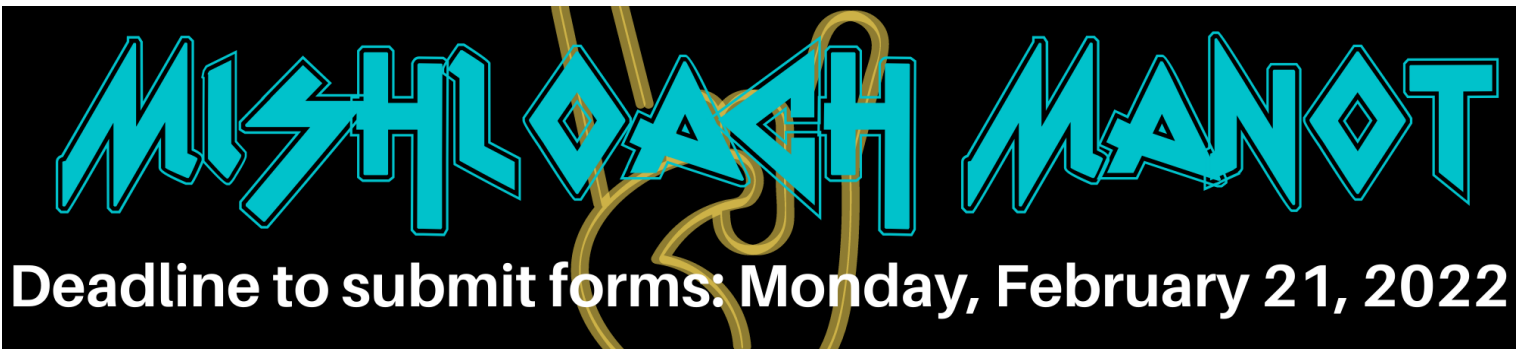
To participate in this community-building event, you can purchase the Mishloach Manot boxes for fellow congregants online through the membership portal.

In the wake of the destruction of the Temple, when Jews had lost their sense of whether and how their relationship with God would continue, the rabbis began to offer additional and diverse ways of envisioning God's role in world affairs.

February 9: Divine Intervention: Human Initiative

What does a Divine-human partnership look like? In the previous class, we noted that even in interventionist moments, God enlists the leadership of human beings. How are Divine intervention and human initiative related to one another?

February 16: Faith and Tragedy

When tragedy strikes, how do people understand their relationship with God? Why and how do people maintain a relationship with God when they are struggling and perceive God to be absent?

February 23: Faith and Blessing

The rabbis offered ways to bring God into one's everyday life rather than waiting for personal revelation. One mechanism they offered for developing a consistent relationship with God is to declare God's presence in moments of awe.

Stop The Bleed.

Clarence Jorif, U.S. Secret Service Agent (Ret) teaches an in-person training limited to 75 participants.



This national awareness campaign and call-to-action is intended to cultivate grassroots efforts that encourage bystanders to become trained, equipped, and empowered to help in a bleeding emergency before professional help arrives.

No matter how rapid the arrival of professional emergency responders, bystanders will always be first on the scene. A person who is bleeding can die from blood loss within five minutes, therefore it is important to quickly stop the blood loss. Those nearest to someone with life-threatening injuries are best positioned to provide first care.

You may be able to save a life by taking simple actions immediately after the trauma. The course provides an overview of the Stop The Bleed mindset and hands-on life-saving training.
