UNDERSTANDING ACROSS FAITHS

St. Luke Community United Methodist Church Hosts Weitzman Family Religious School For Sunday Christian Service



Rabbi Ari Sunshine, Weitzman Family Religious School students and their families joined together with the congregation of St. Luke Community United Methodist Church to celebrate traditional Sunday services. St. Luke,

an African American church with Dallas roots going back to 1933, is led by senior pastor Rev. Richie Butler. Commenting on the genesis of their relationship and this trip, Rabbi Sunshine said, “Reverend Butler and I met about four years ago



when we both spoke at a ceremony for International Holocaust Remembrance Day at the Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum. We immediately hit it off and became friendly and met for breakfast soon thereafter to get to know each other better and talk about opportunities for partnership among

our congregations. In January of 2020, Reverend Butler and his congregation were guests at our MLK Shabbat Service, and during the Shabbat dinner he and I presented a dialogue on African American and Jewish relations to those gathered from our communities. Reverend Butler and I had been talking about doing a pulpit swap one weekend when the pandemic hit, so I’m thrilled we were able to pick up where we left off and bring our teens and parents to visit his congregation in action”.

This year, our high school students have been traveling around the metroplex with our rabbis--visiting seniors at The Legacy, touring the Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum, and dropping off sandwiches at a shelter in South Dallas. Attending a service at St. Luke helped our students appreciate the connections Shearith Israel has made with other faith traditions and faith leaders.

Teddy Fleiss, a 9th grade student noted, “one major difference between St. Luke’s and Shearith is how much louder and more festive St. Luke’s felt.” Zachary Zable, impressed by the exuberance of the service, declared the entire experience as, “... current and hip. Like what you see on a TikTok video.”

The students’ visit to St. Luke highlights the benefit of experiencing other religious practices first-hand. The Weitzman Family Religious school students learn not only Jewish values and traditions, like our lay leaders and klei kodesh, they are also urged to become involved in our wider community.

From Evan Drazin, WFRS student:

I enjoyed getting to see a Christian service. The difference between a formal Jewish service and the service at St. Luke’s was night and day. The



service was significantly shorter, yet still seemed to hit all of the same ideas that a Saturday service would hit. The service also had a big

focus on people actively involving themselves in the service, whereas at a Saturday morning service you typically have a few people leading different pieces of the service.

“It was a pleasure having you here!”, commented associate pastor Reverend Sharon L. Larkin of St. Luke.

Perhaps the congregants of St. Luke, after having hosted our students and their families, have a better understanding of Jewish life as well. Knowing that our students took the time to visit their church, it is not too much of a stretch to assume the bridge that has been built between our two communities will grow even stronger.

The Shearith community expresses its sincere thanks to Pastor Butler and his congregants for hosting such a meaningful expression of the precept “you shall love your neighbor as yourself.”
