We greatly appreciate our playground committee—Sarah Davis, Staci Reznik, and Sarah Lipinsky—for their leadership and insight.

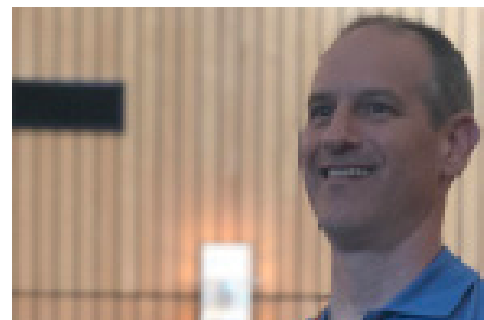
